For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.25 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent Police.

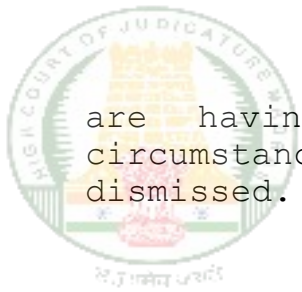
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-
