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ORDER

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited relief sought for, there shall be a direction to the third respondent to consider the representation made by the petitioner on 20.01.2020 and to deal with the same on its own merits and in accordance with law and pass orders within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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5. The petitioner is directed to make a fresh representation to the third respondent along with all the relevant documents and also a copy of this order.

6. This Writ Petition is disposed of in the above terms. No costs.
