Prayer in Crl.A(MD)No.330 of 2023:-

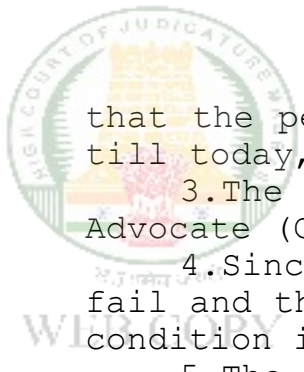
