other orders as this Honble Court.

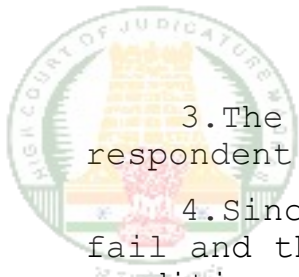
Prayer in CRL A (MD)No.742 of 2022:-
