Today, the W.P.(MD)No.16362 of 2017 filed by one Latha Kumari was taken up for hearing and this Court has dismissed the aforesaid Writ Petition. Therefore,



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now there is no impediment for the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner college. The respondents shall consider the same and pass orders within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, if it is otherwise in order.
