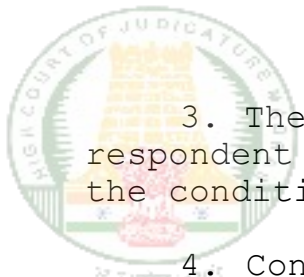
Prayer in CRL A(MD).549/2022 :
