ORDER

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This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to quash the charge sheet in C.C.No.2101 of 2022 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Madurai.

2.The contention of the petitioners is that based on the complaint lodged by the 2nd respondent, the 1st respondent registered the First Information Report in Crime No.26 of 2021 for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 406 and 506(i) of IPC against the petitioners.

3.The further contention of the petitioners is that they compromised the issue with the 2nd respondent amicably. A joint memo of compromise was filed, which has been duly signed by the petitioners and the 2nd respondent and also by their respective counsels.

4.The petitioners and the 2nd respondent appeared before this Court along with their counsels and also produced their Aadhar cards. They were also identified by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and the Investigation Officer. Both the parties were enquired by me and they accepted the terms of compromise. The defacto complainant is present and stated that the matter was compromised between them. Now they are



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resolved to separate mutually by filing proper application before the Family Court, Alandur, Madras, which is pending before there. Total amount of Rs.6,00,000/- was agreed as full maintenance. Rs.3,00,000/- has been paid by way of Demand Draft today. The remaining amount will be paid before the Family Court at the time of passing orders. In respect of other articles and jewels, there is no issue between them. They are received by the defacto complaint. A1 is in abroad and appeared through video conferencing. A2 is present before this Court. Others are not present. Since the issue has been resolved between the parties, the Compromise Memo is recorded.

5.Considering the totality of the circumstances, the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners and also in view of the joint compromise memo, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose will be served by keeping the matter pending and inclined to quash all further proceedings in C.C.No.2101 of 2022 pending on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Madurai in respect of the petitioners.

6.In the result, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and the entire proceedings in C.C.No.2101 of 2022, pending on the file of the



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learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Madurai is hereby quashed in respect of the petitioners alone. The compromise memo is recorded and the terms of joint compromise memo shall form part of this order.
