ORDER

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that on the basis of the order passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi, in Crl.M.P.No.803 of 2023, enquiry was undertaken. During the course of enquiry, it was found that it is a civil dispute between the parties with regard to the title over the property. Therefore, the parties were advised to workout their remedy through civil process. It is also found that the complaint that flex board has been illegally taken is also not true. Therefore, the above said complaint has been closed.
