2.The first petitioner is the wife and the second petitioner is the son of the first respondent and they have filed a petition in D.V.C.No.18 of 2021 before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Melur, against the respondents, under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.
