Prayer : This Criminal Appeal is filed under Section 14(A)(2) of the Schedule Caste and the Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, to call for the records pertaining to the order dated 13.06.2023 in CrI.M.P.No.1846 of 2023 on the file of Sessions Judge, Special Court for Trial of SC/ST (POA) , Act Cases (FAC), Virudhunagar District at Srivilliputtur, and to set aside the same and enlarge the appellant on bail in Crime No.18 of 2023 on the file of the first respondent by



allowing this Criminal Appeal.
