Prayer in CRL A(MD)No.143 of 2020 :

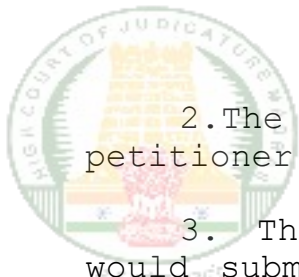
