ORDER

When the matter was taken up today for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the respondents 4 and 5 has submitted that this petition is filed challenging the impugned order passed by the first respondent under Section 145 of Cr.P.C., and already final order was passed and produced a copy of the order and the same was served on the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
