This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr.K.Sudalaiyandi and the counsel for the respondents Mr.Pandeewaran for Mr.A.Theethar are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Both parties are present and they accepted for a sum of Rs.52,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Two Lakhs only) as full quit. Both parties are agreed to that the appellant shall deposit the balance amount in three installments. The first respondent/first petitioner is entitled for a sum of Rs. 30,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lakhs only). The second respondent/second petitioner is entitled for a sum of Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs only). The third respondent/third petitioner is entitled for a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only). The first installment will be paid within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The second installment will be paid after one month from the date of the first installment. The third installment will be paid within a period of one month from the date of the second installment. After depositing the entire amount, the respondents/petitioners are entitled to withdraw the same without filing any formal permission petition before the Tribunal. The appellant/Transport Corporation shall pay the amount after deducting the already deposited amount. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
