PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.375 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Sole Accused who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 174 of Cr.P.C. @ 306 of IPC, in Crime No.375 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the deceased is a husband of the petitioner and having one male child, namely, Puvinan aged about 7 years. The deceased person frequently consumed alcohol and quarrelled to the petitioner herein. Subsequently, the petitioner's husband voluntarily suicide through hanging and he was died. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard. Perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

4.It is seen that the petitioner had illegal intimacy with the deceased. It was questioned and due to the said humiliation, the

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husband of the petitioner committed suicide by hanging. How the learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the deceased used to come with alcohol things and as such, the deceased committed suicide. Even then before his death, there was no instigation or abetment by the petitioner to commit suicide by the deceased.

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5. Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on her appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Karaikudi, Sivagangai District, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police, daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
