Prayer in WMP(MD).13118/2023:

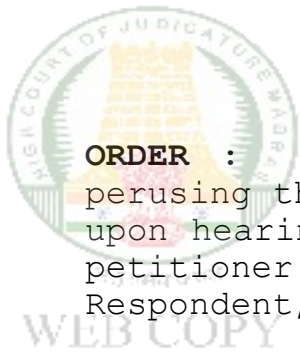
