Seeking modification of the condition imposed upon the petitioner and seeking extension of time to comply the above said order, these petitions have been filed.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was directed to deposit the original title deeds of immovable property worth about Rs.5,00,000/- by the order dated 06.04.2023, but he is not in a position to mobilise the sureties for Rs.5,00,000/-.

3. Considering the fact that jewellery is involved in the above said case, so that the above said condition has been imposed upon the petitioner. Hence, this Court is not inclined to modify the above said condition and CrI.M.P(MD) No.10018 of 2023 is dismissed. Consequently, the time granted by this Court vide order in CrI.O.P(MD) No.2303 of 2023 is extended further for a period of **fifteen days** from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Hence, CrI.M.P(MD) No.10019 of 2023 is allowed.
