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ORDER

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This criminal original petition has been filed seeking to quash the FIR in Crime No.24 of 2021 dated 16.05.2021 on the file of the first respondent Police.

2.The contention of the petitioners is that based on the complaint lodged by the 2nd respondent, the 1st respondent registered the First Information Report in Crime No.109 of 2022 for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 406, 506(2), 294(b) of I.P.C. r/w Sections 3(1), 4 and 6 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

3.When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) would submit that after completing the investigation final report has been filed before the Additional Mahila Court, Nagercoil, and the same has not been taken cognizance so far. Hence, the prayer sought for in this petition has become infructuous.

4.Since the final report has been filed before the concerned Court, the petitioner can workout his remedy through appropriate proceedings,



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if so aggrieved by the contents of the final report. The Additional Mahila Court, Nagercoil, shall process the above said final report within the time stipulated as per Rules.

5.With the above said liberty, this criminal original petition stands dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
