Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S. ALAGUMANI.R, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.A.THIRUVADI KUMAR, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondents, the Court made the following order:-

Complaining of certain medical ailments with regard to the petitioner's eye vision and pain in her hand, the petitioner, who is detained in the third respondent prison, seeks for a direction to the first respondent to admit her in Government Rajaji Medical College Hospital, Madurai for medical treatment.

2. Today, when the matter was called, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on written instructions, submitted that the only major medical ailment, which the petitioner had, was to her vision, for which a cataract surgery was performed at the Government Rajaji Hospital between 08.07.2023 and 14.07.2023 and she has also been discharged. The copy of the medical certificate has also been produced before us.

3. Thus, the medical ailment, which the petitioner is complained of has been taken care. In case, the petitioner is undergoing any other medical ailment with regard to her hand, it is open to her to approach the jail authorities seeking for such treatment in the jail hospital.



With the observation and direction, this petition is closed.
