deposit Rs.3,65,000/- to the credit of Crime No.12 of 2023 before the trial Court.



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2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that while granting anticipatory bail to the co-accused namely A1 & A2, the trial Court directed them to deposit a sum of Rs.50,000/- each to the credit of the crime number. Therefore, the above said condition imposed upon the petitioner may be relaxed.

3. Out of Rs.3,65,000/-, Rs.1,00,000/- was deposited by the co-accused persons. Hence, by deducting the above said amount of Rs.1,00,000/-, the petitioner is directed to deposit the balance amount of Rs.2,65,000/- to the credit of the crime number. In view of the above said order, the time for execute the sureties is extended for further period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The other conditions in the said order remains unaltered. Accordingly, this criminal miscellaneous petition stands disposed of.
