PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to remove the FIR in Crime No.98 of 2010 from the CCTNS (Crime and Criminal Tracking Network System) on the file of the second respondent as per the petitioner's representation dated 12.05.2023 pending on the file of the second respondent within a reasonable time.

The petitioner has filed a copy of the letter, wherein, the Inspector of Police has addressed the letter to the Immigration Officer of Airport, Trichirappalli, informing that Look Out Circular was pending in C.C.No.4 of 2018 and that the petitioner was acquitted as per the Judgment, dated 14.02.2020, by the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Alangulam, thereby, the Police should have updated CCTNS (Crime and Criminal Tracking Network System).

5. Learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) on the other hand, submits that, though the petitioner stated to have sent a representation to the respondent Police, no such representation has been received and submitted that the Police will take steps to delete C.C.No.4 of 2018 from the CCTNS (Crime and Criminal Tracking Network System).

6. Considering the circumstances, the respondent Police is directed to dispose of the representation dated 12.05.2023 within a four of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
