This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.S.Srinivasa Raghavan and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr.K.Esakkidurai are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / Insurance Company has preferred the present appeal.

Both the parties agreed to settle the matter in the following terms:-

The claimant has agreed to receive a sum of Rs.20,00,000/- with interest from the date of petition and the Insurance Company has also agreed to deposit the said amount. Out of Rs.20,00,000/-, the claimant is permitted to receive a sum of Rs.7,00,000/- with interest and the remaining amount of Rs. 13 00 000/- shall be deposited in any of the Nationalised Bank. The claimant is entitled to withdraw the accrued interest once in six months. The claimant is permitted to file a petition for withdrawing the deposited amount by citing sufficient reason.



The Insurance Company is directed to deposit the remaining the amount after deducting the amount already deposited within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
