ORDER

This criminal original petition has been filed seeking to quash the FIR in Crime No.105 of 2022, dated 12.03.2022 on the file of the first respondent Police.

2.The contention of the petitioners is that based on the complaint lodged by the 2nd respondent, the 1st respondent registered the First Information Report in Crime No.105 of 2022 for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(1) of I.P.C. r/w Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002.

3.When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) would submit that after completing the investigation final report has been filed before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II,
