Sathiyamoorthy, aged about 23 years as 'Goonda' who was originally confined in District Jail, Pudukkottai subsequently he was transferred to the Central Prison, Tiruchirappalli, Tiruchirappalli District and now he is confined at the Central Prison, Tiruchirappalli, Tiruchirappalli District and quasht eh impugned order of detention and set him at liberty by producing him before this Court.

ORDER

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dated 09.08.2022, holding him to be a "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982. The said order is under challenge in this Habeas Corpus Petition.

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents has submitted that the detention order, which is impugned herein, has already been revoked by the competent authority. Therefore, the prayer sought for herein has become infructuous.
