AWARD



Aggrieved by the Award by the Tribunal, the appellant/claimant has filed the present appeal.

Now, both the parties appeared and the claimant agreed for enhanced amount of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) with 7.5% interest from the date of petition till the date of deposit in addition to the amount already awarded and the second respondent/insurance company is directed to deposit the award amount of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) with 7.5% interest within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On such deposit, the appellant /claimant is entitled to withdraw the award amount of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) with 7.5% interest on filing necessary application before the Tribunal.
