PETITIONS FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.163 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-



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The petitioners/ Accused apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under Sections 294(b), 353, 324, 506(i) of IPC and Section 3(1) of Prevention of damage to public property Act, 1934 in Crime No.163 of 2023, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 30.06.2023, the petitioner along with other accused persons herein alleged to have made quarrel with the nurse of the hospital while they were taking treatment, in which, they caused injuries to the nurse and also caused damages to the bench and door of the hospital worth Rs.2,000/-. Hence the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent, he has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that the other accused were granted anticipatory bail by the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Thanjavur.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and also considering the fact that the co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail and this petitioner also standing in the same footing, this Court is inclined to grant relief to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is

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ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvaiyaru, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail will stand dismissed.
