This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr. K. Sudalaiyandi and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr. A. Sivaji are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

After due deliberations, both the parties have entered into compromise and agreed to settle for a sum of Rs. 21,75,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Lakhs and Seventy Five Thousand only) as full quit. The appellant has already deposited a sum of Rs. 25,000/- before the Tribunal.

The appellant/Transport Corporation is directed to deposit the entire award amount, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this award, failing which the appellant shall pay the award amount together with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum.

On such deposit being made, the respondent/claimant is permitted to withdraw their entire share amount as apportioned by the Tribunal by filing formal application before the Tribunal.
