Pursuant to which, the revision petitioner filed G.W.O.P.No.43 of 2023 before the I Additional District Judge, Trichirapalli, to declare her a a natural guardian and to remove the 1st respondent name from the child's birth certificate.

3.Since both the cases are pending before two different Courts, the revision petitioner filed Tr.O.P.No.231 of 2023 before the District Court, Trichirapalli. The learned trial Judge is proceedings the GWOP filed by the first respondent in a speedy manner and kept the Tr.O.P pending and if the GWOP has been decided, the Tr.O.P became infructuous and his right will be defeated.
