PRAYER: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus forbearing the respondents 3 and 5 from constructing modern fish shop in the land classified as Salai, comprised in S.No.1036, Highway margin, maintained by the highways department, at Iyampalayam Town Panchayat, Aathur Taluk, Dindigul District, obstructing the petitioner's ingress and egress to his land comprised in S.No.1037/6 abutting to the Dindigul-Iyampalayam Highways Road (Thanikudi-Vathalagundu) highway boundary situated in the land in S.No.1036.
