PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.284/2023 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(B) and 29(1) of NDPS Act, in Crime No.284 of 2023, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in illegal possession of 4 Kgs of Ganja. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner delivered a baby on 30.09.2023.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police submits that no previous case is pending against the petitioner.

5.Considering the facts and the circumstances of this case and also the fact no previous case is pending against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, however, with stringent conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or her appearance, before the learned Principal Special Court for NDPS Act Cases, Madurai, and on her executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned; and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police on every Saturday at 10.30 am until further orders. The petitioner shall

comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail will stand dismissed.
