ORDER

This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking for a mandamus directing respondent Nos.3 to 5 from directing them to provide protection to the petitioner against respondent No.7, who has been from trespassing or causing hindrance to the petitioner's property in respect of the property in Old S.No.141/2 in New S.No.369/3 situated at Ariyamangalam Village.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he is the senior citizen and the owner of the property bearing Old S.No.141/2 in New S.No.369/3.
