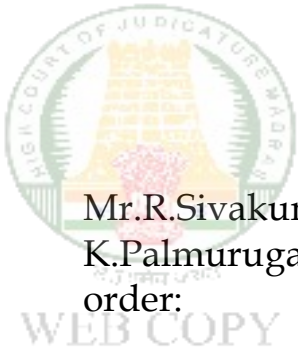
**Prayer in CRL.MP(MD)No.12589 of 2023:-**
