**ORDER**

Heard the learned counsel on either side.

2.The petitioner had filed writ petition before this Court for conducting survey of the petition mentioned land. The jurisdictional Tahsildar informed the petitioner that survey had been conducted and four boundaries have been fixed. The communication issued by the jurisdictional Tahsildar contained enclosures. The same was put to challenge in this writ petition.

3.The stand of the writ petitioner is that the survey was conducted in the absence of the petitioner and without giving him any notice.

4.When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Special Government Pleader submitted that the writ petitioner passed away on 24.05.2018 and that his wife does not want to pursue the matter.
