PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.126 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/ Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent

Police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) IPC,



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in Crime No.126 of 2023, on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

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2. The case of the prosecution is that on 04.07.2023 at about 4.00 p.m., the accused persons quarrelled with the defacto complainant and his friend, abused them with filthy language and also assaulted them with bottles. The accused persons also threatened them with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he is an innocent person and is not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. In this case, the injured has been discharged from the hospital. There is no specific overt act attributed against the petitioner as per the First Information Report. Hence, prays to release him on anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that though the injured has been discharged from the hospital, the petitioner is having four previous cases to his credit. In which, he was convicted in Crime No.7 of 2009 and paid fine and in other three cases, two were registered for the offence of criminal intimidation. Hence, prayed to dismiss the petition.

5.Heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and perused the materials placed before this Court.

6.Considering the nature of the case, he seems to be a habitual offender, I find no change of circumstances, since the petitioner was present in the place of



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occurrence, whether there is any specific overt act attributed against this petitioner or not is the matter for investigation. Also considering the bad antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to him.

7. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
