## **ORDER**

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This Criminal Original Petition is filed seeking for a direction to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 Police not to harass the petitioner basing on a complaint allegedly given by the respondent No.4.

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the petitioner and the respondent No.4 used to run a bakery business jointly and the dispute arouse between them. In respect of that, the respondent No.4 has filed a false complaint before the Police.
