PETITIONS FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

COMMON PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.195 of 2012 on the file of the Respondent police.

COMMON ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/ Accused apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under Sections 447, 379, 406, 420 of IPC r/w 3(1) of TNPPDL Act and 4(1)A, 4(2)A, 4(3) and 21(b)(5) of MMDR Act, 1967 in Crime No.195 of 2012, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is the Village Administrative Officer, Keelavalavu Village. One Coromandal Agency was licensed to quarry granite stones in S.F.No.264/1, 264/2A, 2b, 2C, 3, 264/4A, 4b, 5, 6 to an extent of 4.25.0 hectares in Keelavalavu Village, Melur Taluk, Madurai District vide G.O.Ms.No.3D No.20 dated 27.07.1993. But they illegally trespassed and quarried in the adjoining Government unused lands in S.F.No.267/2 to an extent of 377 Sq.mt. Hence the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocents, they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. They have been falsely implicated in this case.



4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that final report has been filed before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Melur on 08.11.2022 and taken cognizance in PRC No.60 of 2022, showing this petitioners as absconding accused. Only summon has been issued to the petitioners.

5. Let the petitioners appear before the committal Court and execute a bond under Section 88 of Cr.P.C., or as required by the committal Court.

6. With this direction, this Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
