This Petition is filed to condone the delay of 283 days in filing the Criminal Revision Case before this Court.

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3. The learned counsel for the respondent has raised the formal objections.

4. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the respondent and also perused the materials placed before this Court.

Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, the delay of 283 days in preferring the Criminal Revision Case is condoned on payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), by the petitioner to the respondent within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which, this petition shall stand dismissed automatically without further reference to this Court. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is allowed.

6. If the amount paid within a time stipulated by this Court, Registry is directed to number the Criminal Revision case, if it is otherwise in order and list the same for admission.
