### **ORDER**

2.The case of the petitioner is that the third respondent, who had encroached upon the property belonging to the petitioner, had put up a thatched house and had got the service connection from the respondent department. A representation was made for disconnecting the service connection and since the same was not considered, the present Writ Petition has been filed before this Court.
