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passed by the 2nd respondent against the petitioner's son namely, Jestin Stalin, son of T.Charles, aged about 31 years, who is detained under sub section (1) of Section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Cyber law offenders, Drug offenders, Forest-offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand offenders, Sexual-offenders, Slum-grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 (Tamilnadu Act 14 of 1982) read with orders issued by the Government in G.O.(D)No.90, Home, Prohibition, and Excise (XVI) Department dated 11th April, 2022 under sub-section (2) of Section 3 of the aforesaid Act and confined at Tiruchirappalli Central Prison, Tiruchirappalli District before this Court and set him at liberty.
