This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.S.Srinivasa Raghavan and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr.K.Gopalakrishnan are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / Insurance Company has preferred the present appeal. Pending the appeal, the first respondent and the third respondent died and their only legal heir second respondent has already come on record.



The settlement arrived at between the Insurance Company and the second respondent is as follows following terms :



After negotiations, the second respondent agrees to receive a sum of Rs.1,55,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Five Thousand only) as full quit. The appellant/insurance company is directed to deposit the award amount, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. On such deposit, the second respondent is permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.1,55,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Five Thousand only) on filing necessary application before the Tribunal.
