PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.147/2023 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/2nd Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 328 IPC and Sections 6(b), 24(1) of Cigarette and other Tobacco Products Act, 2003, in Crime



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No.147 of 2023 on the file of the respondent Police, seek anticipatory bail.

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2. The case of the prosecution is that on 20.07.2023 at about 9.30 a.m., when the defacto complainant and other Police officials roaming nearby the Maharajapuram north street, the first accused was found in a suspicious manner and kept a white color gunny bag. On enquiry found that the accused carrying prohibition material of tobacco products and the same was recovered. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. This petitioner is sister-in-law of the first accused and only for the statistical purpose, this false case has been registered.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent police submitted that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner.

5. Considering the nature of offence and there is no previous case pending against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Srivilliputhur, Virudhunagar District, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees



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Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioners shall appear before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
