COMMON ORDER

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2. The contention of the petitioners is that the College has appointed them on the respective date stated in the appointment orders. But the Government has granted approval 6 months / 1 year / 2½ years belatedly. The contention of the petitioner is that the other Lecturers were granted approval from the date of appointment through the second respondent proceedings in Na.Ka.No.9639/G4 /2015, dated 25.01.2016. Therefore, the claim of the petitioners is to consider the petitioners case in the light of Na.Ka.No. 9639/G4/2015, dated 25.01.2016.

3. Therefore this Court directs the official respondents to consider the petitioners claim and pass appropriate orders within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, the Writ Petitions are disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
