PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.227 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 324, 341



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and 506(2) of IPC, in Crime No.227 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

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2. The case of the prosecution is that on 15.07.2023 at about 8.45 a.m. one Thangapandi, Karthick and some other including the petitioner waylaid the defacto complainant and his wife and used abusive words against them and attacked the defacto complainant and caused blood injuries to him. The defacto complainant was admitted in the hospital as inpatient. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. The co-accused namely A1 was granted anticipatory bail by the learned Principal District Judge, Theni.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent police submitted that investigation is still pending. The injured in this case has been discharged from the hospital.

5. Considering the nature of offence, the injured person has been discharged from the hospital and the co-accused have been released on bail, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam, on condition that the petitioner shall



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execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
