The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent also admitted that the petitioners are complying with the conditions till 12.09.2023 and thereafter they failed to comply with the conditions from 13.09.2023 to 15.09.2023. He further submitted that the petitioners have complied the conditions from 16.09.2023 to till date.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that they went to hospital for treatment and hence they are unable to comply with the conditions.

5. Considering the representation made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) and considering the fact that the petitioners are complying the conditions from 11.08.2023 and considering the nature of offence and considering the reason stated by the learned counsel for the petitioners in the affidavit for not complying the conditions from 13.09.2023 to 15.09.2023, this Court is inclined to relax the condition. Accordingly, the condition imposed on the petitioners is relaxed in toto.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is allowed.
