Insofar as CrI.O.P.(MD) No.17094 of 2023 is concerned, it is submitted that the investigation has already been completed and closed as mistake of fact and RCS notice was also served on the defacto complainant. Insofar as CrI.O.P.(MD) No. 17096 of 2023 is concerned, it is submitted that the police have completed the investigation and the charge sheet is ready to be filed and reported that within shortly, they are going to file the charge sheet.

3. Accordingly, these Petitions are disposed of with the following directions:-

i) In CrI.O.P.(MD) No.17091 of 2023, the respondent police are directed to complete the investigation and file the charge sheet in Crime No.1210 of 2020 as quickly as possible, not later than 4 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

ii) Insofar as CrI.O.P.(MD) No.17094 of 2023 is concerned, since the investigation has already been completed and final report is also filed, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the concerned Magistrate and file a petition protesting the closure of the complaint.
