PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.84 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Sole Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 506(i) of

I.P.C and 4 of TNWH Act, in Crime No.84 of 2023 on the file of the respondent Police,

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seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 30.08.2023 at about 5.00 p.m., the defacto complainant's cow came back from the field. At that time, the defacto complainant saw her cow's leg injured and when the same was enquired with the petitioner, he was abused in filthy language and threatened with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent and no such occurrence happened as alleged in the complaint. Due to previous enmity, the false complaint has been foisted against the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent Police submitted that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and also considering that no previous case is pending against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruppathur, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned



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and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
