3. In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, both the petitioners in W.P.(MD).Nos.22385 and 22523 of 2023 are directed to approach the respondent Police and file a fresh application, on which, the respondent Police are directed to give permission by imposing suitable conditions.

4. With this direction, these Writ Petitions are disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
