PETITIONS FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.220 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/ Accused apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under Sections 147, 294(b), 323, 324, 427 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.220 of 2023, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.



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2. The case of the prosecution is that on 09.06.2023 at about 1.30 p.m., a wordy quarrel arose between the defacto complainant and the accused persons. In this incident, the petitioner alleged to have abused and assaulted the defacto complainant and also threatened with dire consequences. Hence the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent, he has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that trouble arose over a simple wordy quarrel between the parties. The injured person sustained only simple injuries. The co-accused in this case have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 23.06.2023.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and also the fact that the co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail, this Court is inclined to grant relief to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Andipatti, Theni District, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate



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concerned and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail will stand dismissed.
