“Considering the limited request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, though the petitioner has not impleaded the Block Development Officer, Devakottai as a party, since no adverse order passed as against the Block Development Officer, Devakottai, this Court directs the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 28.02.2020 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after providing opportunity to the concerned Block Educational Officer, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.”
