ORDER

This writ petition is filed seeking for a mandamus directing the respondents 4 to 6 to dispose of the representation dated 18.09.2023.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents 1 to 6 submitted that the respondent police have not received any representation from the petitioner.

3. Mr.D.Rajesh, learned counsel intervened on behalf of the 7th respondent requested time. However, the said request is declined since the



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request of the petitioner is to give a direction to the respondent police to dispose of the representation of the petitioner.

4. Considering the submissions, this writ petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to submit a fresh representation before the respondent police directly duly signed by him, on which, the respondent police are directed to consider the representation of the petitioner by speaking to all the stakeholders concerned in respect of the issues and also keeping in view that the festival is scheduled to be held on 03.10.2023. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
