The learned Counsel for the petitioner would submit that even though it is ancestral property, after partition they are cultivating their separate portions. In respect of the above said partition, the private respondents are making trouble by throwing liquor bottle. Over which, the representation was made. On the basis of the representation enquiry has been
